The manuscripts must be written in English and they must follow the APA style. Authors are invited to submit full papers (NOT MORE THAN 6000 WORDS including all text parts) responding to one of the topics described above. Previously published articles or proceedings will not be accepted.

All submissions will be double-blind peer-reviewed. Accepted conference proceedings will be published in "The Image Journal" and AJOL.
